The Lombardi Comprehensive Cancer Center at Georgetown University Hospital in Washington DC is a National Cancer Institute-designated Comprehensive Care Center. Its primary objective is to provide the most advanced treatments available, and ultimately find a cure for this devastating disease.

The Problem:

The Center contacted ACE Envirotech when they experienced an underground drain pipe failure. The eight inch diameter pipe was 70 feet in length and ran 20 feet below the surface between the Lombardi Cancer Center and the Marriott at Georgetown University. Digging to repair the line was out of the question. Shut downs to the Cancer Center were also out of the question.

The solution was to use the ACE DuraFlo in place, eLiner[®] system. The ACE DuraFlo[®] system allows the existing drain line to remain fully operational during the eLiner[®] installation. The project was completed over eight days without any disruption of service to the Marriott Hotel or the Lombardi Cancer Center.
